


## St. Lucia Labour Force Survey 1st Quarter 2019 Statistical Report



The Unemployment rate in the first Quarter of 2019 was 15.5%. This represented a reduction of 4.32% when compared to the 16.2% for the fourth quarter of 2018. Similarly, Youth Unemployment also experienced a reduction for the period under review (i.e. fourth quarter 2018 compared with first quarter 2019), of -21.51%.




The Labour Survey results revealed that the youth<sup>1</sup> population continues its increasing trend from 36,148 for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2018 to 36,711 for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2019, representing an increase of 1.6%. Correspondingly, the youth labour force grew by 6.9%, while youth employment grew by 18.3%. Notably, the results revealed a decline in the population, labour force and employment of male youths, of -9.5%, -14.6% & -3.8% respectively, in contrast to the increases experienced by female youth.

The employed Labour force recorded an increase of 1.4% for the reporting period, with female employment experiencing growth of 8.58% from the previous 4<sup>th</sup> quarter 2018 period to the first quarter 2019. At the same time, male employment decreased by 4.1% for the period under review. The largest increases in employment were in the areas of activity related to 'Wholesale & Retail Trade', 'Accommodation & Food Service Activities' and 'Public administration and defence, compulsory social security'. Wholesale & Retail Trade together with the Accommodation & Food Service Activity accounted for the lion's share of the increases, respectively registering increases of 4.9% and 14.7% from the fourth (4<sup>th</sup>) quarter of 2018 to the first (1<sup>st</sup>) quarter of 2019.
